

RACE PADDOCK STAND **LEVEL-140H** instructions manual

(ver.1.0 2020/1)

Important Notes

- LEVEL-140H is a bicycle storage stand that hooks the saddle nose on the horizontal bar. Do not use this stand for any other purpose.
- Bikes on LEVEL-140H may swing and hit each other unexpectedly from strong winds even though the front tire is touching the ground. A small frame bike that does not reach the ground should not be used due to stability issues.
- Use LEVEL-140H on flat and horizontal floor/ground. Make sure all 4 legs touch the floor/ground at same time to achieve maximum stability.
- Do not use LEVEL-140 for any other purposes than instructed. Do not step on the bar, the maximum load is 40 kgs. Placing more weight will compromises the stand.

- The top bar is designed to be sligtly bent intentionally, and not straight, when not in use.
- You need to assemble this product by yourself. No tools required. Disassembling should be done in the opposite steps from when assembling.
- Be careful not to pinch your palm or finger when assembling or disassembling.
- There are some points that will become fragile temporarily while assembling. Do not apply too much force at that time. Handle gently.
- LEVEL-140H is made of light alloy material to make it as lightweight as possible. Do not mishandle as this could cause damage not covered by warranty.

Warranty Period : 1 year

Minoura offers 1-year limited warranty to this product from the date of your purchase. You need to keep the sales slip issued by the retailer which clearly shows your purchase date upon request from Minoura if you want to use this service program.

Minoura shall reserve the right to replace or repair the parts or product from any problems caused by manufacturer's defect. 

How To Assemble LEVEL-140H

Required Tools: None

1 Open the carry bag, and pull out the Horizontal Bar from the Leg.





When storing, engage the Bar between the Legs.

Make sure the rivet of the Bar comes in the cut-out section on the Legs.

To do so, the bar's bottom end must be inserted into the rubber cap on the Leg.

2 Open the Connecting Bracket from the Bar.

Hook Insertion Point

(Fig. O)

Open the Legs to clamp the Horizontal Bar.
